PERFORMING/PARTICIPATING STUDENTS

Students who will be performing and/or participating in the assembly (i.e. Band, Color Guard, Choir, Drill, Dance, and ASB) will be excused for Period 1 and 2 and will report to their advisor before school starts. Advisors will send out a list of students who are excused from class to the attendance office.

PERIOD 2 - GRADES 9th & 10th - FIRST ASSEMBLY

Students will report to their 2nd period class after nutrition. Teachers are to take attendance and escort their students to the Big Gym. Students must leave their backpacks/bags with their 2nd period classroom. For mixed grade classes, teachers will attend the assembly for the grade level that most closely matches their roster counts. All students/teachers will attend one of two assemblies. The assembly will end at 10:40am, at which time teachers are to escort their students back to class. Instructional time (70 minutes) has been set aside for period 2.

PERIOD 2 - GRADES 11th & 12th - SECOND ASSEMBLY

Students will report to their 2nd period class after nutrition; 70 minutes of instructional time has been set aside at the beginning of the period. **At 10:45am,** teachers are asked to escort their students to the Big Gym. Students must leave their backpacks/bags with their 2nd period classroom. For mixed grade classes, teachers will attend the assembly for the grade level that most closely matches their roster counts. All students/teachers will attend one of two assemblies.

STUDENTS ARRIVING LATE - AFTER NUTRITION

Students who arrive late to school, once assembly has begun, will report to their 2nd period class. If their class is attending the assembly, they will report to the cafeteria and remain there until the assembly ends.

STUDENT EXPECTATIONS

Before escorting their students, teachers are asked to go over student expectations while attending the assembly. Assembly guidelines:

- 2. Recognize other's accomplishments with enthusiastic clapping and cheers.
- 3. Please, NO booing or inappropriate yelling or whistling.
- 4. Please respect and follow the directions given to you by any staff member.
- 5. No backpacks/bags will be allowed in the Big Gym; they will be taken to the AP Office.
- 6. Students whose behavior interferes with assembly will be escorted from the gym.
